

# PACK 421 FALL 2008 CAMPOUT – FRIDAY, OCT. 24 THROUGH SUNDAY, OCT. 26

Check in on Friday begins at 3 p.m.; checkout Sunday is 1 p.m.

**Where?** Prado Regional Park, Chino – Driving directions on [www.scoutpack421.com](http://www.scoutpack421.com) - see Events page

**What do they have?** Fire pits, raised BBQs, picnic tables, playground, potable water, restrooms, showers

**What if I want to bring my RV?** RV campers must make their own additional individual reservations and payments to the park for RV spaces - contact campground at (909) 597-4260. RVs NOT PERMITTED IN GROUP TENT SITE.

**Are dogs allowed?** Dogs are permitted by the campground but must be on a 6-ft. leash at all times and cannot be left unattended; \$1 per dog per day payable upon arrival to the ranger. If you think your dog will not be able to handle a lot of kids, is noisy, or is at all aggressive to people or other dogs, please do not bring it. *If you bring your dog, you do so at your own risk: the Pack/BSA will not assume any liability for injury to the dog or injury caused by the dog.*

**What do I bring?** Families should provide their own food, drinks, and all necessary camping supplies (tents, sleeping bags, chairs, etc.) for the weekend. Families that need to borrow camping supplies from the pack should contact Steve Miller, Quartermaster, at [smiller@catalystpharma.com](mailto:smiller@catalystpharma.com).

**What does it cost?** Breakdown is as follows:

**Payable to “Pack 421” no later than October 15 or when space runs out:**

- TENT CAMPERS: \$12 per adult or non-scout child. This covers your tent camping fee, cracker barrel, and non-scout crafts/activities.
- RV CAMPERS: \$6 per adult or non-scout child (plus your separate RV charge that you are paying to the park individually).
- SCOUTS ARE FREE. All scout costs for tent camping and activities are covered by their dues and fundraisers.

**Additional payable upon arrival at the park – be prepared to pay the ranger in cash at the gate:**

- Fishing Fee (Optional): \$7 per person, if park permits (TBD upon arrival at camp).
- Families bringing dogs will be charged \$1 per dog per day upon arrival.

***Every camper should bring their own WHISTLE, MUG W/CARABINER, FLASHLIGHT, and PORTABLE CHAIR. Scouts and leaders must bring their full Class A uniform and Class B t-shirt also.***
